



# RN to BSN

## Part-Time Plan of Study

1. All nursing classes, with the exception of NUR 4604: Professional Seminar and Organizational Development (ODL), and Public Health (PUBH) courses, are 7 weeks in length.
2. This plan **does not include any general education requirements that may be required.** Required general education courses can be found by running a degree audit in Degree Works. This is found under the “student” tab in Paws.
3. **Statistics** must be taken prior to or concurrent with NUR 3703: Research in Professional Nursing.
4. Requirements for graduation include completion of 32 hours of nursing core coursework and any general education requirements. **True Undergraduates** must also submit 3 writing samples from coursework to the Electronic Writing Portfolio.
